**Guidelines & Agreement** for use of on-site  
**Winter Tubing Hill**

The Ghormley Tubing Hill is provided for the enjoyment and education of campers and guests. This is a very steep tubing run and is typically safe when operated properly. Injuries are possible, especially when irresponsible or careless activity takes place on the Tubing Hill. The Tubing Hill is to be used only under direct authorized supervision.

Operating Instructions:

1. Each Tubing Hill participant is to be supervised while using the Ghormley Tubing Hill Run by responsible adult leadership.
2. Each group's medical officer is strongly encouraged to be present when the Tubing hill is being used. The medical officer must at least be available and on the camp grounds while Tubing Hill is being used by their group.
3. Only Inner-tubes, tobaggons, and snow saucers are allowed on the Tubing Hill (Snowboards are not permitted on the tubing run. Snowboards are permitted in other nearby locations as directed by the Ghormley staff).
4. Begin use of the Tubing Hill with great caution as snow conditions and terrain variations can change dramatically from one day to another. It is strongly recommended that each group begin by starting only a short way up the hill and then gradually increase the distance at which tubers begin their run as is safe for the current conditions.
5. Tubing is only permitted on the one Tubing Hill designated for such use at the far southern end of the large Meadow on the Ghormley grounds.
6. Only one person coming down the Tubing Hill at a time is permitted (collisions are one of the greatest potentials for injury). Tubers should descend Tubing Hill feet first.
7. Beginning tubing from beyond upper limit (cable strung between trees) is not permitted.
8. Construction of jumps or ramps is highly discouraged. If you and your group do create such a jump or ramp great caution should be used to insure safety. Any jump or ramp will need to be removed following your groups use of the hill.
9. Tubes are available from Ghormley at no charge. If tube is destroyed during use by your group, your group is responsible for the replacement cost of the tube (\$10-14)
10. Please do not throw objects (including hard snow) at Tuber as they are descending hill.
11. When climbing Tubing Hill, tubers should stay to the left of the downhill run.
12. When you and your group have completed using the Tubing Hill please:
  - a. Stack the inner-tubes in one location near the Tubing Hill
  - b. Report any problems you are aware of in your use of the Tubing Hill to your Ghormley contact
13. Please do not supervise, or have others from your group supervise, the Tubing Hill unless you (they) have been fully trained (under the direction of Ghormley staff) and feel confident in your (their) abilities to operate it safely and within the above guidelines. As the responsible leader, I have read the above guidelines and agree to supervise the Ghormley Tubing Hill under these directions and instructions:
